Knox Road, Elm Street see closures next week for sewer work

A small portion of *Knox Road* just east of Roanoke Road is scheduled to be closed for two days beginning Monday, May 16, allowing for safe construction of a deep sewer connection for the Oakbrook Hills subdivision. Weather and field conditions permitting, workers with Pennington Utilities, LLC hope to have the road fully reopened late Tuesday, May 17. During the closure, traffic will detoured via Ottinger Road and Melody Lane.

Elm Street (Whitley), likewise, is scheduled to be closed at Pecan Street from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday, May 16 for sewer line work. Traffic will be detoured via Main Street/Hwy. 377. For more information about either of these projects, contact the Public Works Department at 817-743-4080.

Keller seeking volunteers for boards and commissions

Keller residents have until Friday, May 20 to apply for one or more of eight city boards and commissions. The City Council is now accepting applications for the following:

- *Keller Development Corporation:* Administers expenditures of the City's one-half cent sales tax revenue for park development, and implements the City of Keller Parks Master Plan.
- *Keller Economic Development Board:* Advises the City Council on issues related to economic development, including development planning and marketing.
- *Parks and Recreation Board:* Advises City Council on issues related to the city parks system, including recreational programs and facilities.
- Planning and Zoning Commission: Advises City Council on issues related to commercial and residential development, zoning, development plans, and master plan amendments.
- *Library Board:* Advises City Council on matters related to the Keller Public Library programs, public services and facilities.
- *Public Arts Board:* Advises City Council on events, programs and activities pertaining to the Public Arts Program.
- **Zoning Board of Adjustment:** Considers appeals and adjustments to the city's zoning ordinances.
- *Metroport Teen Court Advisory Board:* Represents the City of Keller as a participating city of the Metroport Teen Court program.

Applicants must be residents and qualified voters of the City of Keller. The application is available on the city website or from the Office of the City Secretary at Keller Town Hall during normal business hours. Applications are due by 5 p.m. Friday, May 20.
