The Keller Citizen Academy is a free, 10-week program designed to take residents behind the scenes of city government. Join us for a series of presentations, tours, demonstrations and more to learn about everything from parks to police, public works to public arts and everything in between. **Applicants must be Keller residents aged 21 or older and registered to vote in the City of Keller.**

The 2016 Keller Citizens Academy will be held from 6-8 p.m. on nine consecutive Thursdays beginning Sept. 1, 2016 with graduation scheduled at the Keller City Council meeting on Tuesday, Nov. 1, 2016. Most sessions will be held at Keller Town Hall, 1100 Bear Creek Pkwy. Others will be held at city facilities, including the Keller Police Department, Fire Station 1, the Municipal Service Center and the Keller Public Library. Participants will also be asked to attend one of three Keller City Council meetings scheduled during the course.

Applications may be left at the front desk of Keller Town Hall and are **due by 5 p.m. Friday, July 29, 2016.** Applicants will be notified of their acceptance into the course no later than Friday, Aug. 12, 2016.
