## **Demolition Permit Requirements**

ALL UTILITIES (electrical, plumbing, water, etc.) are to be disconnected, capped off and left exposed for an Investigative Inspection to be scheduled BEFORE removal of structure(s).

- Septic Tanks are to be decommissioned (pumped and crushed) based upon permitting and/or reporting requirements through Tarrant County Health Department (TCHD). TCHD documentation shall be submitted to Development Services PRIOR TO or UPON Investigative Inspection. (If upon inspection, documentation shall be attached to this permit).
- Swimming Pools are to be drained and all utilities disconnected. The drain shall be crushed and **left exposed** for inspection **BEFORE** fill or removal.

The property owner is the responsible party for cleaning the lot once the structure is removed. Lots shall be cleaned within 30 days of demolition.

Senate Bill 509 requires municipalities to verify that an asbestos survey has been conducted prior to issuing permits for public or commercial buildings.
